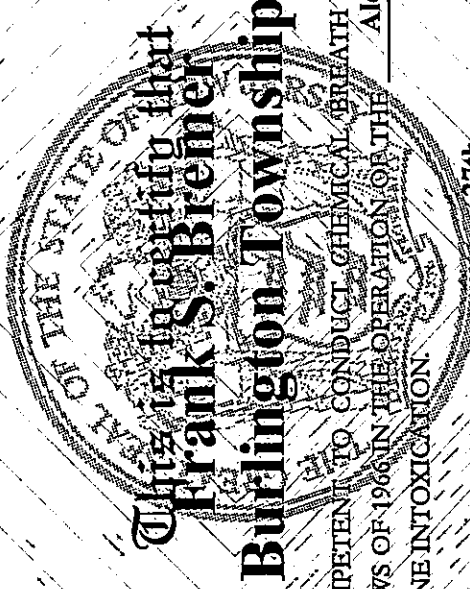

Dear Colleague:

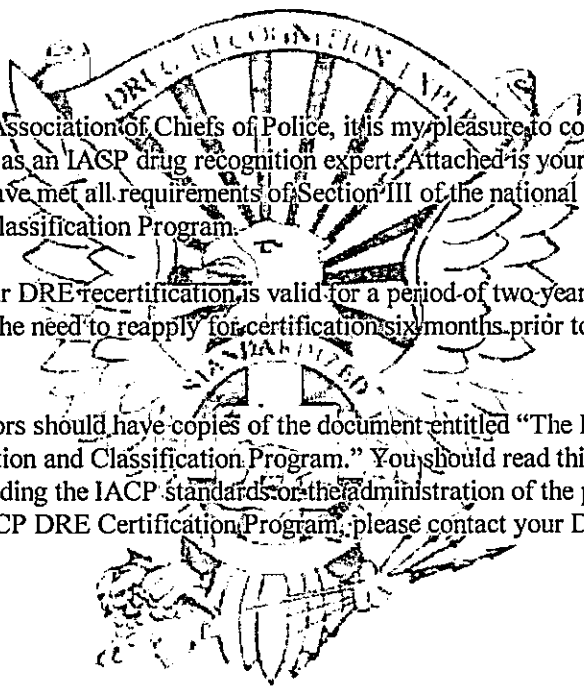
